GIFT AID DECLARATION

I want the charity to treat all donations I have made since 6 April 2002, and all donations I make from the date of this declaration as Gift Aid donations, until I notify you otherwise.

I understand that I must pay an amount of United Kingdom income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on my donations in each tax year (currently 25p for each £1 given)

NOTES

1. From 6 April 2008 the UK Government will add an extra 3p for every £1 donated under Gift Aid, which means that a charity will receive a total of 28p for every £1 donated.
2. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax, you should cancel the declaration by notifying the charity.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
